**ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF CURTILAGE CHANGE TO APPROVED

Further to the approval of the above establishment under Regulation (EC) No 853/2004¹, granted on 13 February 2008 to operate as a **cutting plant** for the cutting of meat from **domestic ungulates, farmed birds and lagomorphs** and as a **minced meat and meat preparations** establishment; the further approval granted on 18 December 2008 to operate as a **cutting plant** for the cutting of meat from **wild game** and the further approval granted on 23 December 2013 to operate as a **cold store**, I am writing to acknowledge receipt of the new plan of the establishment, reflecting the extensions you have made, which is shown on the enclosed site plan.

Following the on-site visit to the above establishment on 7 January 2015 and recommendation by Jacqueline Rodriguez, Field Veterinary Leader, the Food Standards Agency (FSA) is content to acknowledge the change to the curtilage of the establishment.

The approved establishment comprises all those buildings, rooms and areas within the boundary outlined in red but excluding the crosshatched area, on

the attached plan. Any buildings or areas outside the area outlined in red or inside the crosshatched area must not be used for any activities connected with the proper running of the establishment.

The area marked with diagonal lines denotes an area of shared facilities between FSA approved activities and Local Authority approved activities. These shared facilities are included in the approved area and approval is granted on the basis that facilities being shared remain available and the requirements of regulations continue to be fulfilled. When carrying out official controls, if the FSA needs to take enforcement action in regard to the shared facilities, this may be taken against both parties regardless of which party caused the problem.

Please keep this letter and revised plan together with your approval document.
